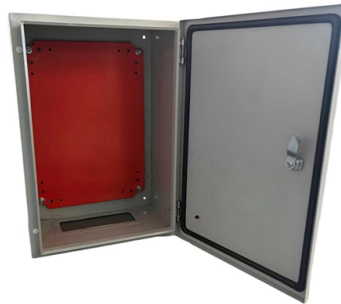
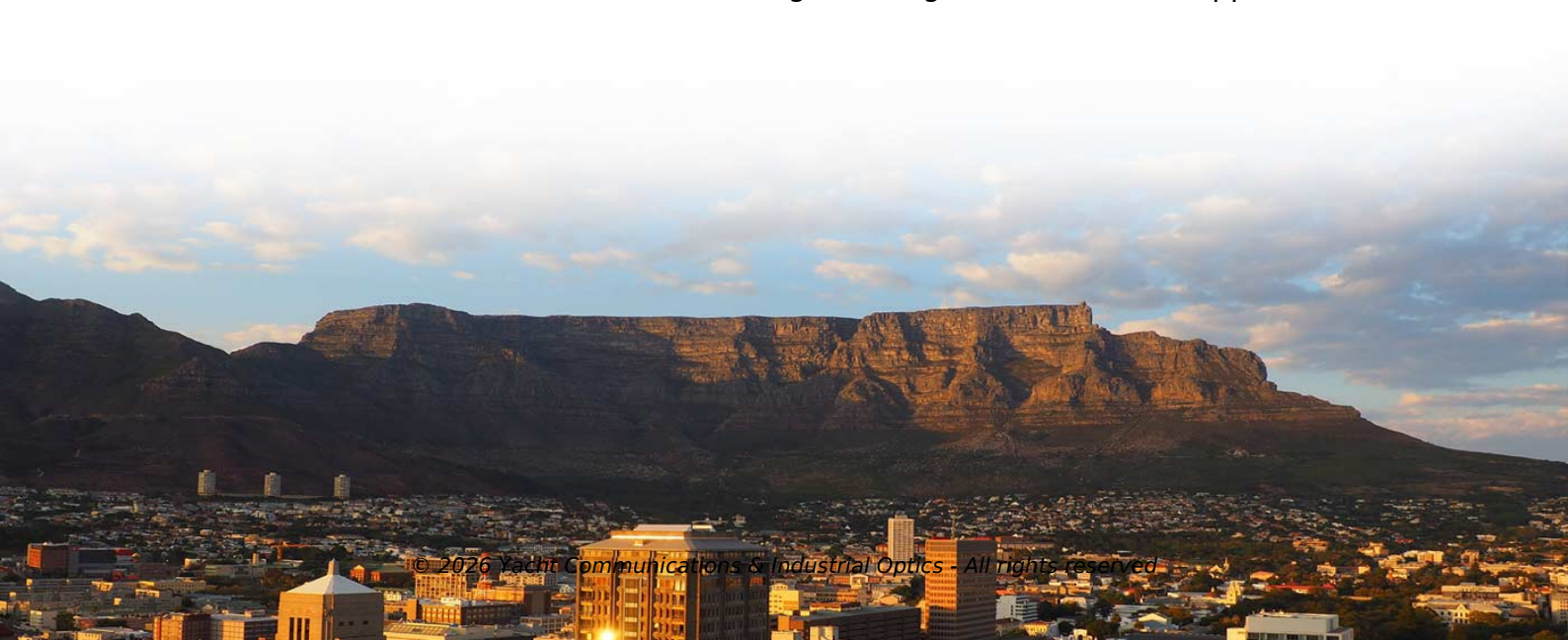


What does the figure-eight flexible optical cable mean



Overview

Figure-eight optical cable is a type of optical cable specifically designed for aerial installation. It integrates optical fiber units with high-strength steel suspension wires (or reinforcing members) through a polyethylene (PE) sheath. Viewed from the end, the cross-section of the optical cable. Commonly referred to as figure 8 cable, figure 8 fiber cable, figure 8 aerial cable, self-supporting figure 8 cable, or simply figure 8 optical cable, this ingenious structure combines optical fibers with an integrated messenger wire in a distinctive “8” cross-section. The loose tube design provides stable performance over a wide temperature range and is compatible with any telecommunications-grade optical fiber. Characterized by its unique “Figure 8” profile, this cable incorporates a steel stranded wire as its self-supporting component, offering unparalleled tensile strength during both. One term in fiber optic jargon is particularly confusing, because it has a dual meaning—“figure 8.
