

What does the red light on an optical cable represent

A red light on an optical cable typically indicates a connection fault, error, or failure in the optical signal.

Optical Network Terminals (ONTs) and Fiber Connections

In fiber-optic systems, the red light on an ONT or optical port usually signals a problem with the connection or signal transmission. For example:

- **Link or Optical Light Red:** The ONT has failed to establish a connection with the fiber network, or the fiber signal is not being received properly .
- **Data Light Red:** Data transmission has failed or is severely impaired .
- **Alarm Light Red:** The ONT has detected an error or fault that requires attention . If the red light appears, common troubleshooting steps include checking that the optical cable is securely connected, restarting the ONT, and contacting your ISP if the issue persists .

Digital Audio Optical Cables

For digital audio optical cables (TOSLINK), a red LED may be visible when the optical output is active but no cable is connected. This red light is the optical signal itself, which is normally invisible to the naked eye when the cable is properly connected .

- **Red Light Visible:** Indicates the optical output is active but the cable is not connected or the connection is faulty .
