

What is a buried optical cable

A buried optical cable is a fiber optic cable installed underground to transmit data securely and reliably while being protected from environmental and physical damage.

Definition and Purpose

A buried optical cable is a type of fiber optic cable that is laid beneath the ground surface to carry digital data, including internet, telephone, and private communications. Unlike overhead cables, buried cables are hidden from view, reducing aesthetic impact and exposure to weather, wind, or accidental damage from vehicles or construction activities .

Installation Methods

Buried optical cables are typically installed using direct burial or within protective conduits. Direct burial involves placing the cable in a trench, often with a layer of sand or screened soil at the bottom to cushion the cable. Protective conduits, such as PVC or HDPE pipes, are used in high-traffic areas like roads to provide extra protection and facilitate future upgrades . After laying, the trench is backfilled, and markers may be placed above the cable to prevent accidental excavation .

Burial Depth

The depth of buried optical cables varies depending on location and risk factors:

- Residential or commercial areas: 24-36 inches (60-90 cm) deep
- Under roads or driveways: 36-48 inches (90-120 cm), often within a conduit for added protection
