

What is a switch with only one optical port



Overview

This modular design allows a single switch port to support fiber optic, copper Ethernet, or direct-attach cable connections without changing the switch hardware itself. Switches come in three types: those with only electrical ports, those with only optical ports, and those with a mix of both electrical and optical ports. There are two main port types: optical and electrical. An SFP port on a Gigabit switch is a modular interface that accepts Small Form-Factor Pluggable (SFP) transceiver modules. This Fiber Optic Connector vs Ethernet Port, what is the difference?

To use the switch's 10-Gigabit optical port, you need to plug in SFP+ 10-Gigabit. Enterprise LANs use the RJ45 port on 100/1000BASE switches.
