What It Is

An optical output splitter, also known as a Toslink splitter, is a device that takes one optical (Toslink) input and splits it into two or more outputs. This enables a single audio source, such as a TV, Blu-ray player, or gaming console, to send its digital audio signal to multiple devices simultaneously, like a soundbar and an AV receiver .

How It Works

The splitter receives a digital audio signal through its input port and distributes it to the output ports. Many splitters, such as the CYP AU-D12, include amplification to extend the signal range by several meters, ensuring that the audio quality remains high over longer distances . The devices connected to the outputs can simultaneously receive formats like Dolby Digital, DTS, and LPCM, depending on the splitter's specifications .

Key Features

- **Number of Outputs:** Common configurations include 1-in-2-out or 1-in-3-out setups, allowing one source to feed two or three devices .
- **Audio Format Support:** Most splitters support uncompressed PCM audio and compressed surround sound formats such as Dolby Digital Plus, DTS-HD, and LPCM .
