

What is the side length of the cable tray

Cable tray side length, or side rail height, typically ranges from 2 to 6 inches depending on tray type and load requirements.

Overview of Side Rail Height

The side rail height of a cable tray is a critical dimension that affects the tray's load capacity, structural rigidity, and cable containment. Taller side rails allow for heavier cable loads and longer support spans, while shorter rails are suitable for light-duty applications or compact installations. Side rail height is particularly important for ladder trays, which are designed to carry heavy power cables and maximize heat dissipation.

Standard Side Rail Heights

- Ladder Trays: Typically 2 to 6 inches (50–150 mm), with higher rails used for heavy-duty or solar DC cable runs.
- Perforated or Trough Trays: Usually 2 to 4 inches (50–100 mm), balancing cable containment with ventilation.
- Channel Trays: Compact trays with 1.5 to 3 inches (40–75 mm) side rails, suitable for light-duty or instrumentation cables.
- Wire Mesh Trays: Side rails are often integrated into the mesh structure, generally 2 to 4 inches (50–100 mm), prioritizing flexibility over load capacity.

Factors Affecting Side Rail Selection

- Cable Load: Heavier cables require taller side rails to prevent sagging and maintain structural integrity.
