

What is the size of a 24-core optical fiber cable



Article Overview

The typical outer diameter of a 24-core optical fiber cable ranges from approximately 8 mm to 12 mm, depending on construction and protective layers.

Core and Cladding Dimensions

Each fiber in a 24-core cable usually has a core diameter of 9 μm and a cladding diameter of 125 μm for single-mode fibers, which is standard across most telecom and data center applications. The cladding ensures light remains confined within the core, while the core itself carries the optical signal.

Buffer and Coating Layers

Fibers are coated with a protective layer, typically 250 μm for standard coatings or 900 μm for tight-buffered fibers used indoors. This buffer layer adds mechanical strength and facilitates handling during installation.

Cable Construction

The overall cable diameter depends on the type of construction:

- Tight-buffered indoor cables: Usually smaller, around 8–10 mm, suitable for data centers and office environments.
- Loose-tube outdoor or armored cables: Can range from 10–12 mm or more, as they include additional layers such as steel or aluminum armoring, water-blocking materials, and outer jackets for environmental protection.
