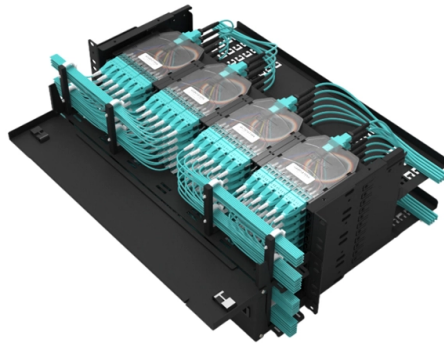


What size router should I buy for fiber optic internet

For fiber optic broadband, choose a router that supports multi-gig speeds, Wi-Fi 6 or 7, and coverage suitable for your home size and number of devices.

Key Considerations

Speed and Wi-Fi Standard: Fiber internet can deliver speeds from 100 Mbps to 10 Gbps. To fully utilize these speeds, select a router that supports Wi-Fi 6 (AX) or Wi-Fi 7, as older Wi-Fi 5 or 4 routers may bottleneck performance. Multi-gig Ethernet ports (1G, 2.5G, or 10G) are recommended for wired connections to high-speed devices.

Coverage and Range: The router should match your home or office size. For example, the Netgear Nighthawk RS700S covers up to 3,500 sq. ft. and supports up to 200 devices, making it ideal for large homes or offices. Smaller homes may only require a Wi-Fi 6 router like the TP-Link Archer AX55, which provides reliable coverage without the premium price.

Number of Devices: Consider how many devices will connect simultaneously. Routers with OFDMA and MU-MIMO technologies handle multiple devices efficiently, reducing latency and maintaining stable speeds.

LAN Ports: If you plan to connect wired devices like gaming consoles or desktop PCs, ensure the router has at least 4 Ethernet ports, with some high-end models offering LAN aggregation for faster combined speeds.

Mesh vs Standalone: For very large homes or multi-floor setups, a mesh Wi-Fi system can eliminate dead zones by distributing the signal evenly. Standalone routers are sufficient for smaller spaces if centrally located.

Security Features: Modern routers often include WPA3 encryption and security suites like NETGEAR Armor to protect against malware and hacking.
