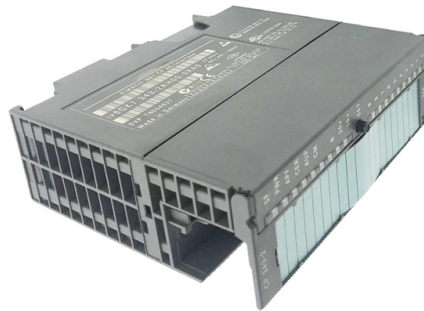


What to do if the fiber optic cable and router are incompatible

Use an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) or a compatible transceiver to bridge the fiber connection to your router, ensuring proper port type, firmware, and configuration.

Check Router and Fiber Compatibility

Fiber optic connections often require specific hardware to convert light signals into electrical signals your router can interpret. Most standard routers cannot connect directly to a fiber cable unless they have a dedicated SFP port or fiber-ready WAN port. Verify that your router supports fiber input and the type of connector used (SC/APC or SC/UPC) .

Use an Optical Network Terminal (ONT)

An ONT is typically provided by your ISP and acts as a bridge between the fiber line and your router. Connect the fiber cable to the ONT, then use an Ethernet cable to link the ONT to your router's WAN port. This setup ensures compatibility even if your router does not have a direct fiber interface .

Update Firmware and Configure Settings

Ensure both your router and ONT (if applicable) are running the latest firmware. Incorrect or outdated firmware can prevent proper negotiation between devices. Check your router's WAN settings: some ISPs require static IP addresses, while others use dynamic IP. Misconfigured IP settings can cause connection failures even if the hardware is compatible .
