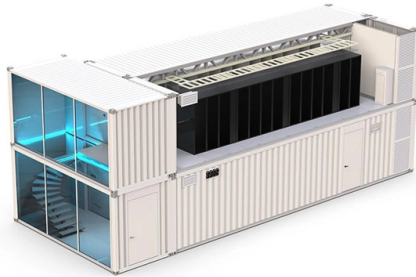


What types of Myanmar are there

Myanmar is home to 135 officially recognized ethnic groups, organized into eight major national ethnic races.

Major Ethnic Groups

Myanmar's population is ethnically diverse, with eight major national ethnic races recognized by the government: Bamar, Kayin (Karen), Rakhine, Shan, Mon, Chin, Kachin, and Kayah (Karenni). These groups are primarily classified based on geographic regions rather than strictly linguistic or cultural lines.

- **Bamar (Burman):** The largest ethnic group, making up about 68% of the population. They mainly inhabit the central lowlands along the Irrawaddy River and speak Burmese, the national language. Most Bamar follow Theravada Buddhism, which strongly influences their culture, architecture, and social customs.
- **Shan:** The second-largest group, residing mainly in Shan State near Thailand, Laos, and China. Shan culture is closely related to Tai peoples, with traditions like stilt houses and rice cultivation in fertile valleys.
- **Kachin:** Found in northern Myanmar, the Kachin are of Tibeto-Burman descent and include 12 subgroups. Traditionally animist, many converted to Christianity after missionary influence.
- **Chin:** Inhabit western Myanmar, with diverse languages and cultural practices. Many Chin people are Christian, and they maintain distinct traditional dress and festivals.
