Suspension Bridges

Suspension bridges use cables suspended between towers to support the bridge deck. They are ideal for long spans and are visually striking. Examples include the Capilano Suspension Bridge in North Vancouver, which spans 140 meters and reaches 70 meters above the river, and the A. Murray MacKay Bridge in Halifax, connecting the Halifax Peninsula with Dartmouth .

Cable-Stayed Bridges

Cable-stayed bridges feature cables directly connecting the towers to the deck, providing strong support for medium to long spans. The Alex Fraser Bridge in Greater Vancouver is a notable example, connecting Richmond and New Westminister with North Delta .

Truss Bridges

Truss bridges use a framework of triangular units to distribute loads efficiently. Canada has several historic and modern truss bridges, including the Quebec Bridge, which has the longest cantilever span in the world at 549 meters .
