Common Wire Types

1. **Copper Wires** Copper is widely used for its high conductivity, flexibility, and durability. It is ideal for power lines, low-voltage wiring, and internal connections in distribution boxes. Copper wires are usually insulated to prevent short circuits and protect against electrical fires, and they can be solid or stranded depending on flexibility needs (). 2. **Aluminum Wires** Aluminum is lighter and less expensive than copper, making it suitable for larger power distribution circuits. It has a lower conductivity than copper but is often used in overhead lines or where weight reduction is important. Aluminum wires are typically insulated and may require special connectors to prevent oxidation (). 3. **Solid vs. Stranded Conductors**

- Solid wires consist of a single conductor and are preferred for fixed installations where minimal bending occurs.
 - Stranded wires are made of multiple thin strands twisted together, offering greater flexibility for routing inside boxes or panels ().
4. **Bare Wires** Bare copper wires are uninsulated and commonly used for grounding purposes. They provide a safe path for leakage currents and are essential for electrical safety in distribution boxes ().
