

Where should the power supply to the primary distribution box be connected



Overview

Power is supplied from the low-voltage side of the transformer at 0.4 kV to the distribution cabinet (primary distribution cabinet), then from there to the distribution boxes of each building (secondary distribution boxes), and further to the distribution cabinets of each unit. Primary distribution systems consist of feeders that deliver power from distribution substations to distribution transformers. A feeder usually begins with a feeder breaker at the distribution substation. Many feeders leave substation in concrete ducts and are routed to a nearby pole. Single Phase Distribution Box generally consists of Double Pole MCBs, Single Pole MCBs, and RCCBs. Primary distribution systems bridge subtransmission and secondary distribution, carrying medium-voltage.
