What a Pigtail Does

A pigtail is a short wire that acts as a bridge between multiple circuit wires and a single device terminal. It allows you to connect several wires securely without overloading a single screw or terminal, ensuring that if one device fails, the rest of the circuit remains operational (electrical safety and redundancy) .

Devices to Connect

- Electrical outlets: The pigtail connects the main circuit wires to the outlet's screw terminals, maintaining power to downstream outlets even if the outlet is removed or fails .
- Light switches: Pigtails allow multiple wires to feed a single switch without crowding the terminal .
- Sensors or automotive components: In vehicles or appliances, pigtail connectors plug into devices like headlights, fuel injectors, or sensors, while the bare wire end connects to the main power source .

- Turn off power at the breaker to ensure safety .
