

Which wire is the incoming power line to the distribution box

The incoming power line should be connected to the main terminals of the distribution box, with proper phase, neutral, and ground connections, followed by secure wiring to circuit breakers.

Step-by-Step Wiring Procedure

1. Safety First Before starting, ensure the main power supply is completely turned off to prevent electrical shock. Use insulated tools and wear protective equipment during installation . 2. Identify Incoming Wires

- Single-phase system: Typically includes one phase (live) wire and one neutral wire, plus a ground wire.

- Three-phase system: Includes three phase wires (commonly red, yellow, and green), one neutral wire (light blue), and one ground wire (yellow with green stripes),

. 3. Mount the Distribution Box Install the box securely on a wall at an accessible height (around 1.5 meters) in a dry, ventilated area . Ensure it is free from obstructions. 4. Connect the Main Power

- Attach the incoming live wire(s) to the main terminal or main MCB. For single-phase, this is usually a double-pole MCB; for three-phase, a 3- or 4-pole MCB may be used .

- Connect the neutral wire to the neutral terminal block.
