

# Wiring Instructions for Secondary Distribution Box



## Article Overview

The wiring process for a secondary distribution box involves careful preparation, proper connection of main and branch circuits, grounding, labeling, and thorough safety testing to ensure reliable and compliant operation.

### Preparation and Installation

Before wiring, select a suitable location for the distribution box: it should be dry, accessible, well-ventilated, and away from water, flammable, or corrosive substances. The ideal height for residential boxes is around 1.5 meters, while industrial boxes may vary depending on surrounding equipment. Ensure the enclosure has the appropriate IP/NEMA rating for protection against dust and moisture, and that it can accommodate all circuit breakers and wiring for current and future expansion.

### Wire Preparation

- Cut the insulation of each wire to expose the conductor, leaving enough length for secure connections.
- Use wires of the correct gauge for the load and breaker rating.
- Follow standard color coding: typically, line (live) wires are brown or black, neutral wires are blue, and ground wires are green/yellow.
